Today's announcement has no impact on the Port strategy to become a hub for renewable energy and first mover to export hydrogen to global markets.

Pattern Energy applied for an allocation of Crown land to support possible future phases of this project, and we look forward to working with Government in the future on this process. However, it should be noted that these Crown lands are not required to successfully develop Pattern Energy's project. Pattern remains fully committed to our project and ensuring its success as a first mover in the global race to develop innovative green fuels infrastructure.
